

Important Details About Training Classes at UVHS

Thank you for choosing to come to the UVHS Training Center for your training needs!

Please take a moment to read these important reminders.

Remember, please come to the first class *with* your dog.

Please bring the following TO CLASS WEEKS 1 THROUGH 6:

- Vaccinations: We only need to see your dog's vaccination records if they have received new vaccinations since the last time they have been to class or your dog have never been to a UVHS class before.
- LOTS of treats. These treats will need to be bite size, really yummy treats like hot dogs, string cheese, etc. No large, hard dog biscuits please.
- A fannie pack, carpenter apron, bait bag...something you can wear to carry treats.
- A six-foot leash...please no flexi-leads!
- A regular flat buckled collar or a martingale collar...please no choke or pinch collars! If you use a halter or gentle leader, please feel free to bring those as well.
- A sense of humor...remember this is going to be fun!!

Classes start on time! Please get there a few minutes ahead of time to be sure that you have all your training aids set up. Give yourself enough time to walk your dog so he can relieve himself before class. Please be prepared to clean up after him.

Drive Directions: Exit 15 of I-89 in NH. Turn right off exit if traveling south on I-89, turn left if traveling north. Go very short distance to stop sign & turn left. The UVHS Training Center is one mile down the road. It is the last building on the right hand side.

Parking: There is ample parking in front of or along side the Training Center or along Old Route 10. Please do not park in the cul-de-sac on Old Route 10 in the wintertime. Please do not park in front of the shelter as parking there is limited to shelter customers.
